Sustainability &
the Environment

A key tenet of the Grillo brand is **simplicity**. This approach is apparent in every area of our business, including our approach to sustainability. A simple product is a more sustainable product: The simpler it is, and the less components it has, the less the environmental impact of its manufacture.



Transportation

Grillo kitchen cabinetry is entirely manufactured in the UK, and supplied directly to the consumer. This not only allows us to keep a close eye on the quality, but also enables us to keep our supply chains as short as possible, ensuring that needless transport between distributors' warehouses is eliminated. All kitchen parts are unassembled for transportation, maximising loading efficiency and thereby reducing the carbon footprint of each component part.

Sustainable materials

We make extensive use of environmentally friendly material in our kitchens.

All worksurfaces are porcelain, a material well known for its environmental credentials. Very little waste is produced during its manufacture, as almost the totality of raw materials, glazes and water can be recycled. It contains no VOCs, and ease of maintenance and a very long life cycle all work to minimize its environmental impact.

With forests in decline in many areas globally, it was important we chose a suitable timber for our kitchens. Iroko is a durable, reddish-coloured hardwood with similar properties to teak, but much more abundant. It is not listed on the CITES Appendices, and is not regarded as an endangered species. Importantly, iroko is very durable in outdoor environments, ensuring a long life cycle that reduces the need for replacement. Forest Stewardship Council certification is available on request.



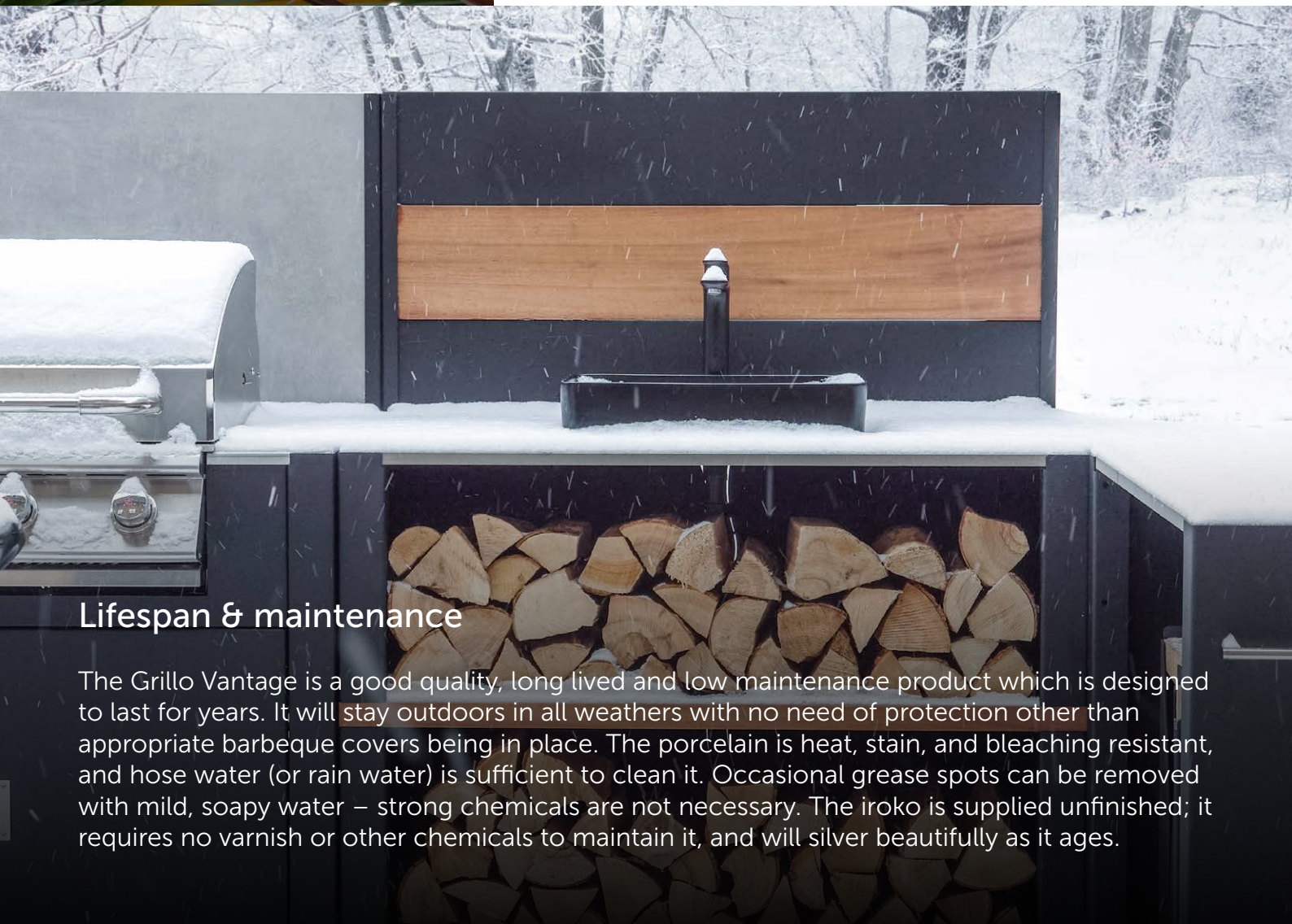


Assembly

Grillo kitchens are configurable – they are designed to be modular in their construction. This means there is very little wastage on assembly. The porcelain comes in standard tiles sizes and does not require trimming.

Planters & the outdoors

Extensive use of planters reduces the carbon footprint of the outdoor kitchen. We suggest planting a range of herbs and shrubs in our planters, depending on your preferences and requirements. These low maintenance plants may encourage an interest in gardening and the outdoors, as indeed we hope the whole kitchen will. Making the outdoors more attractive and easily accessible is key to generating interest in its preservation.



Lifespan & maintenance

The Grillo Vantage is a good quality, long lived and low maintenance product which is designed to last for years. It will stay outdoors in all weathers with no need of protection other than appropriate barbeque covers being in place. The porcelain is heat, stain, and bleaching resistant, and hose water (or rain water) is sufficient to clean it. Occasional grease spots can be removed with mild, soapy water – strong chemicals are not necessary. The iroko is supplied unfinished; it requires no varnish or other chemicals to maintain it, and will silver beautifully as it ages.
