to the correct location

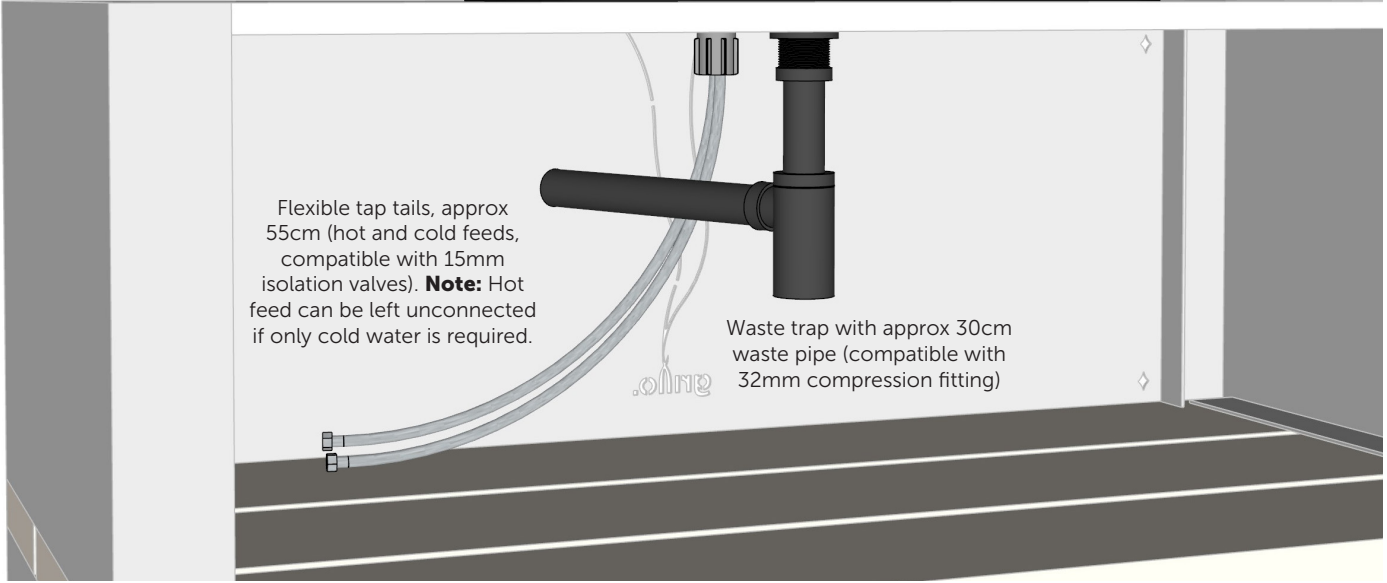
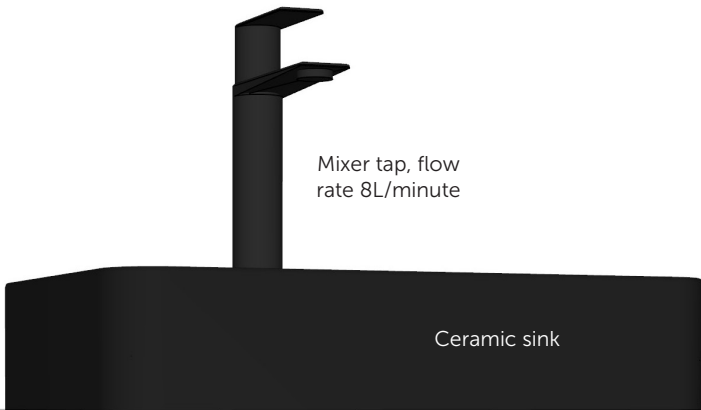


Grillo install team:

kitchen units



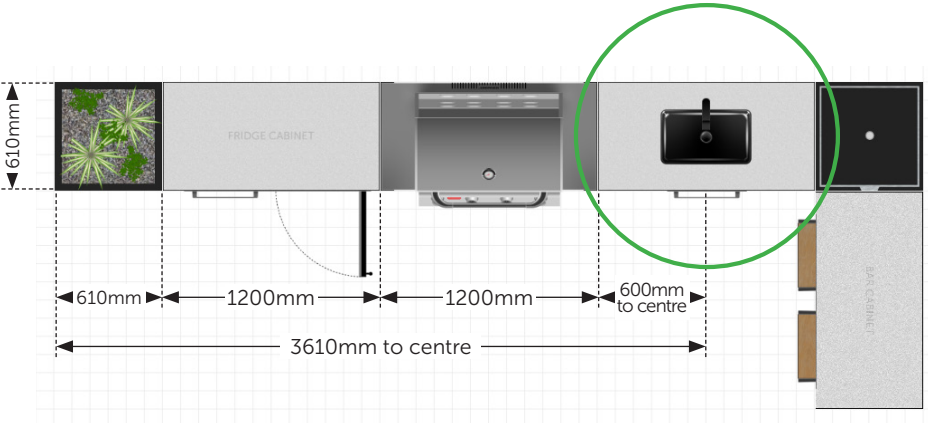

PIPEWORK POSITIONING

Example install diagram:
Large units are 1200 x 610mm.
Small units are 610 x 610mm.

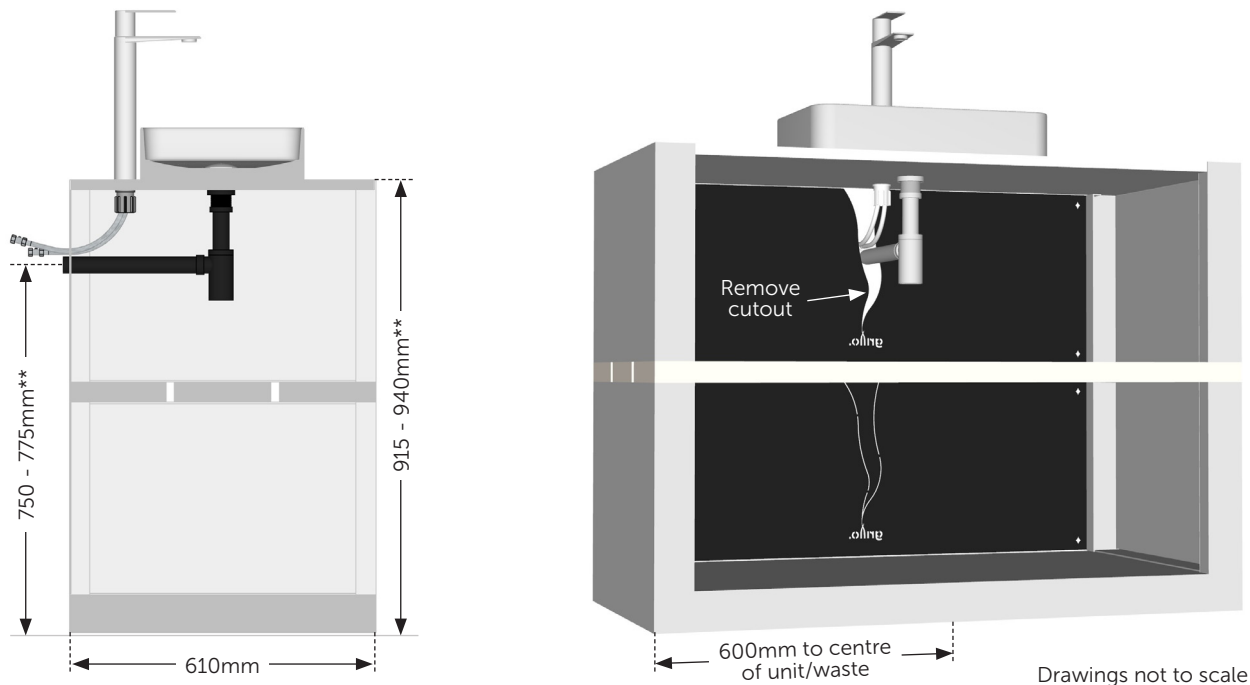


PIPEWORK ROUTING OPTIONS

There are a number of options for routing the pipework. Note that most configurations require permanent modifications to the sink unit, so you must agree a route with your plumber before he commences work.

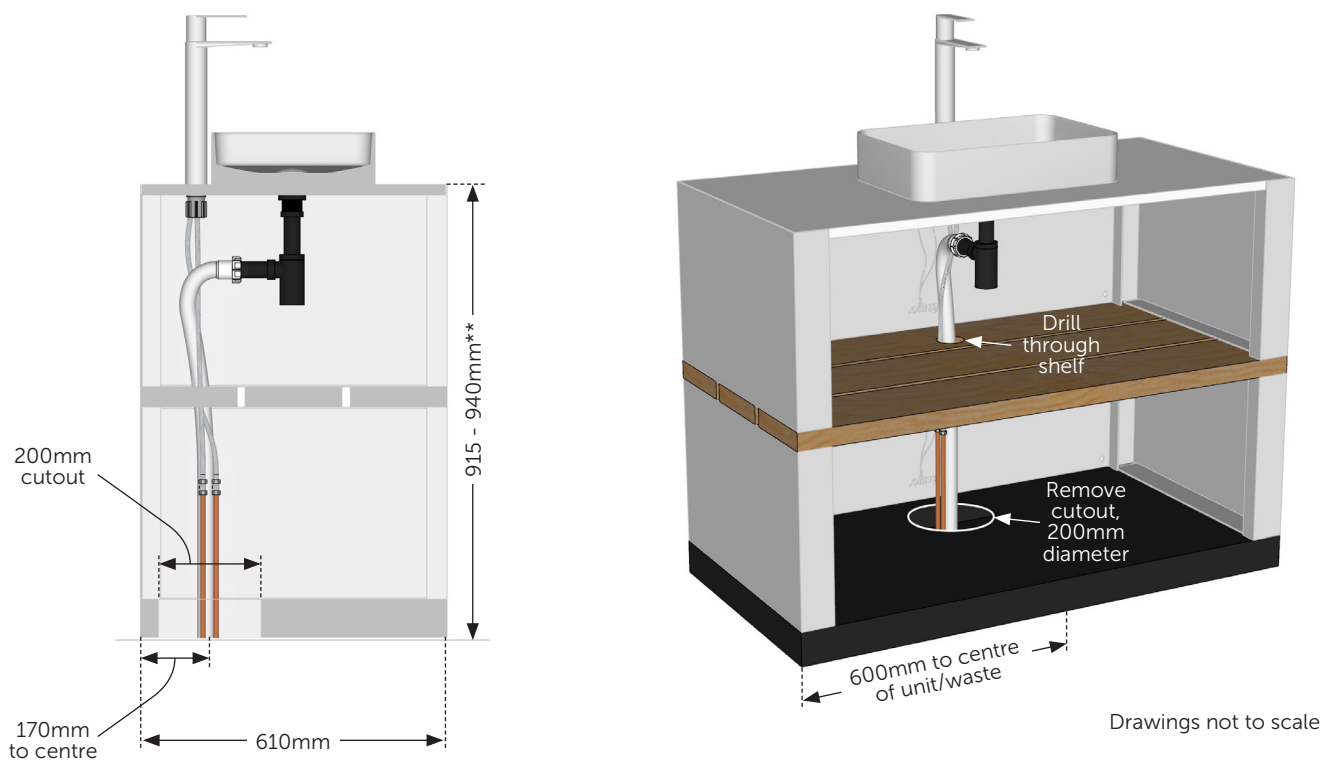
Option A

Run the pipework through the rear fascia by removing the upper fascia cutout*.



Option B

Run the pipework (we recommend using flexible waste pipe) through the base by drilling through the iroko shelf and removing the base cutout*.

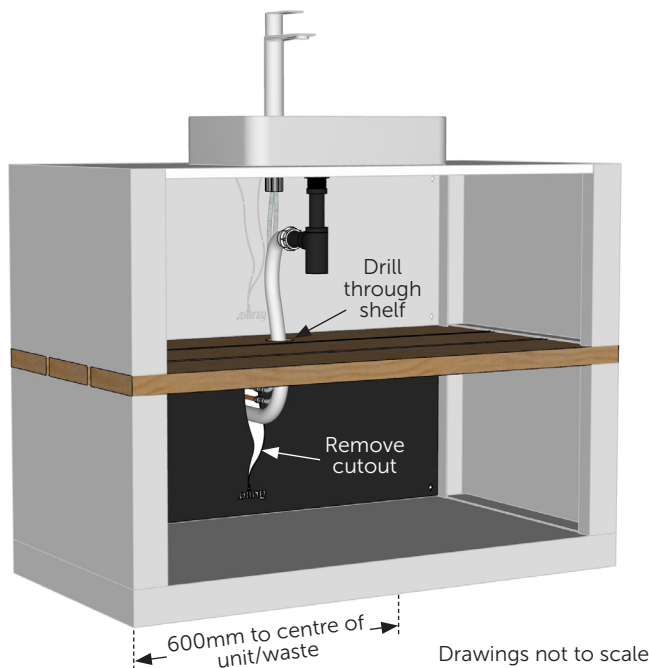
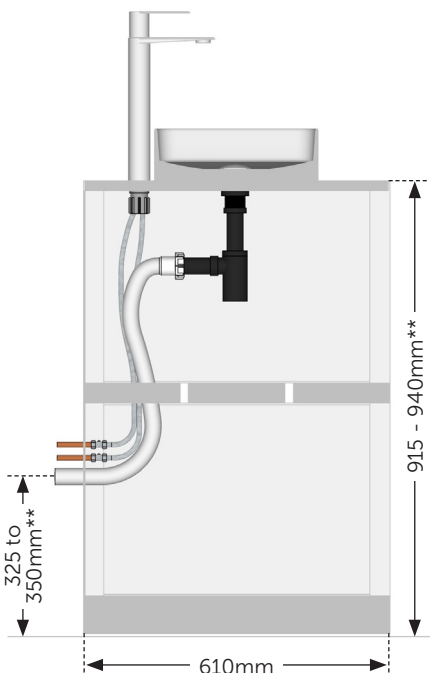


*Please ensure you paint over any exposed steel with the touch-up paint.

**The height variation is for the adjustment provided in the cabinet feet.

Option C

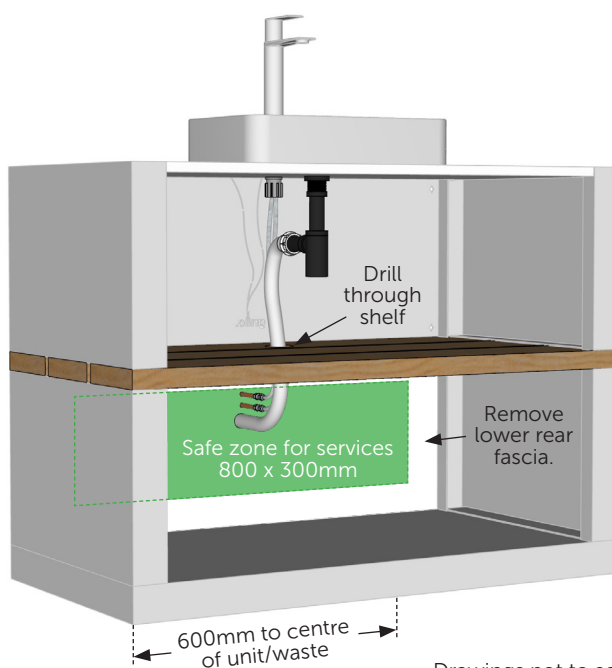
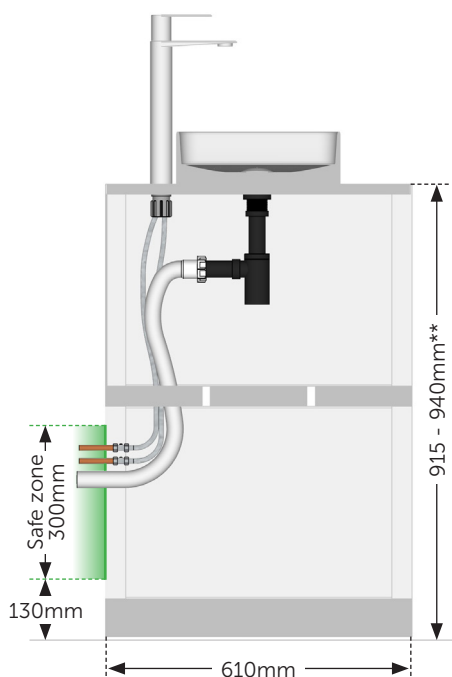
Run the pipework (we recommend using flexible waste pipe) through the rear fascia by drilling through the iroko shelf and removing the lower fascia cutout*.

Option D

Run the pipework (we recommend using flexible waste pipe) through the back of the unit by drilling through the iroko shelf and removing the lower rear fascia. We recommend this is only done where the rear of the kitchen will not be seen and the front will be covered by doors or crates.
